DIRECTOR'S NOTE:


Since the filming of HOLA MAMÁ began in the summer of 2022, several of the adoptees featured in our film, as well as the NGO Nos Buscamos helping to facilitate the reunions, have all received significant press coverage from various news and media outlets.

In September 2023, our adoptees and NGO partner met with President Boric of Chile while in Washington D.C. to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the coup and the killing of Letelier and Moffitt. Press mentions include *Associated Press*, *CNN*, *USA Today*, and others.






